- 1. The Star in the Spotlight
 - A. The Lamb of God ... for imperfect people who need access to God

- B. The Giver of Holy Spirit ... for weak people who need power from God
- C. The Son of God ... for confused people who need a revelation of God
- 2. Freedom for Spotlight Operators
 - A. We are freed to find our identity in relation to Jesus, not on our own.
 - B. We are freed to live with humility that is neither false nor weak.
 - C. We are freed to stop pretending and confess our sins honestly.

- 1. Read Psalm 51:4. What is David teaching us about our sin? How has our society domesticated sin so it doesn't sound so bad? How do you do that in your own life?
- 2. In what area of your life are you prone to stop seeing Jesus clearly for who He is? How can you see Him more clearly as the Lamb of God, the Giver of the Spirit, or the Chosen Son of God?
- 3. A neighbor says, "You seem like a really great guy/gal" or "You go to a really great church." What are some ways you can respond to shine the spotlight on Jesus? (BONUS: What gives you most joy in being a "spotlight operator"?)
