Sin and Suffering? Self or Savior?

1 Peter 4:1-6

1. Put in your own words the “way of thinking” that led Jesus to choose suffering over sin.
2. Will shared several stories of Christians through the centuries who have faced life-or-death choices and chosen suffering over denying Jesus. Which one was most impactful to you?
3. What is a “smaller choice” in your life this week that you will face to choose the path of Savior/suffering over self/sin?
4. What is one specific way in your life you can embrace the truth that “the time that is past suffices” for self-indulgent behavior?
5. Read Hebrews 11:24-26. What are some ways Christians today face the same choice? How would you pray for the young people of our church family as they face these dynamics in new ways?
6. During the service we sang “Tis So Sweet to Trust in Jesus,” “All for Jesus,” “I’d Rather Have Jesus,” and “Give Me Jesus.” Which one is still playing in your head, and why do you want it to shape your heart this week?
