

Sermon Title: Love Song from a Savior

Sermon Text: Hebrews 2:14-18

Sermon Outline

1. God is Near (v.14), Do Not Fear (vv.15–16)
2. Death is Dead, Christ Instead (v.17)
3. Help is Here (v.18)

Why It Matters:

What sin broke, Christ entered.

What death ruled, Christ defeated.

And what still feels undone, Christ is restoring.

Grace Group Questions:

1. Hebrews 2:14–15 says Jesus frees us from “lifelong slavery to the fear of death.” Where do you see fear shaping your decisions, relationships, or life?
2. In what ways do you personally wrestle with the belief that God is truly *near* to you in moments of anxiety, temptation, or suffering?
3. If “death is dead” through Christ, how does that reshape the way you view endings, loss, or uncertainty in your life right now?
4. Verse 18 says Jesus is able to help those who are being tempted. What area of your life most needs His help—and what would it look like to invite Him into that space this week?
5. Where have you noticed—even in small ways—God restoring something in you? Your heart, your relationships, your habits, or your hope? Where have you seen it in others?
