SERMON TITLE: "Loneliness Isn't the End"

MAIN POINTS:

- 1. Jesus prays for lonely hearts to be restored to God's original design of union.
- 2. Jesus prays for his church to be a home for the lonely—a preview of heaven.

WHY IT MATTERS: Loneliness isn't the end of the story. Jesus is.

Grace Group Questions:

- 1. How does Jesus' prayer in John 17 show us God's heart for union and belonging?
- 2. What does it mean for the church to be a "preview of heaven" and a "home for the lonely"? Share a time when you have seen or experienced that kind of community.
- 3. What is one way you sense God inviting you to create space for others who feel lonely?
- 4. In what ways does the cross of Jesus give you hope for your loneliness or the loneliness of others?
- 5. What would it look like for you to "cry out to the Father in the chaos" this week?
