3. What aspect of the kingdom described in Psalm 72 do you most long to experience as a reality? What situations in your life today cause you to ache at the absence of the fullness of Christ's kingdom coming?
4. When you pray "thy kingdom come," what comes to mind in your own life? In this world? In the spiritual realm?
5. What characteristic that King Jesus embodies uniquely are you most grateful for? Why are you glad He is your King?
6. What is one way you can give your time and energy this week to the advancement and anticipation of God's kingdom (rather than your own)?
