My Evangelism Teacher Pt. 2

Matthew 9:35-38

1. How have you experienced the distracted heart/life that Bill referred to as “busy brain”?
2. Do you long for people to listen to and have compassion on you? When have you most experienced that reality?
3. When you consider the people around you, would you describe them as “sheep without a shepherd”? Why or why not?
4. Bill said we can assume brokenness in the people around us. How specifically is that true in your circles of influence? How does knowing the name of the One who will fix it all make us both humble and hopeful?
5. Our “baby step” in evangelism, according to Matthew 9:38, is to pray. Do we sometimes minimize the importance of that? What reality in the text makes it so vital if we long for a plentiful harvest?
6. Share the names of the three people you're praying for and wanting to point to Jesus. What moves your heart with compassion for them, and how specifically can others be praying for you and them?
