

Sermon Title: Jesus Is Greater Than Every Other Anchor

Sermon Text: Hebrews 6:13-20

Sermon Outline

1. God made a promise. (v.13-15)
2. God guaranteed the promise. (v.16-18)
3. God became our anchor. (v.19-20)

Why It Matters: Your soul will only be as steady as the promise it's tied to.

Grace Group Questions:

1. Hebrews says God confirmed His promise with an oath because He cannot lie (vv.13–18). Where do you most need to remember that God's character does not shift? What tends to make you question His faithfulness?
2. The passage mentions those who have "fled for refuge" (v.18). When life feels unstable, where do you instinctively run for security? What does that reveal about what you trust?
3. Our hope in Christ is called "a sure and steadfast anchor" (v.19). What has recently tested your stability? Did it expose anything you were tied to that moved?
4. Jesus has gone "behind the curtain" as our forerunner and High Priest (vv.19–20). Do you live as though you truly have access to God? What keeps you from approaching Him with confidence?
5. Hebrews calls us to "hold fast" to hope. What practical step can you take this week to anchor yourself more deeply in Christ? Who helps you stay anchored when you drift?
