

# Sermon Q's - May 28, 2023

## More Than a Memorial

Luke 22:14-20

1. When you say “remember,” what do you usually mean? Can you think of your own example of remembering meaning actions, attitudes, and words rather than a mere thought?
2. What truths about your relationship with God that you wouldn't “forget” intellectually do you find yourself often “forgetting” practically in the chaos of life?
3. What things do you usually think about in preparation for the Lord's Supper? During the celebration of the Lord's Supper? How have you seen these remembrances impact your life after the Lord's Supper?
4. Will gave several examples of how our lives would be impacted if the reality at the center of our hearts and forefront of our minds in any given moment was the death of Jesus for us because of his great love. How would/could your life be different if this were true for you?
5. How would you explain to a child or an unbelieving neighbor what it means that God “remembers” his covenant when He sees a rainbow or the Lord's Supper? How does God's remembering comfort your heart?
6. How does your heart respond to the idea of celebrating the Lord's Supper more frequently? What is your prayer for your heart and life as we do this together?
