OLD TESTAMENT READING

Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days you shall labor, and do all your work, but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the LORD your God. On it you shall not do any work, you, or your son, or your daughter, your male servant, or your female servant, or your livestock, or the sojourner who is within your gates. For in six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that is in them, and rested on the seventh day. Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.

Exodus 20.8-11

Q. 58. What is required in the fourth commandment? A. The fourth commandment requires keeping holy to God such set times as he has appointed in his Word, in particular one whole day in seven to be a holy Sabbath to himself

Q. 60. How is the Sabbath to be sanctified?

A. The Sabbath is to be sanctified by a holy rest all that day from worldly employments and recreations that are lawful on other days, spending the whole time in the public and private exercises of God's worship, except what is taken up by works of necessity and mercy.

Comfort for Troubled Hearts: Jesus offers Himself as our hope.
1. Let not your heart be troubled: is preparing a home for you (14:2).
2. Let not your heart be troubled: Your true home is with (14:3).
3. Let not your heart be troubled: is all you need to get home (14:4-6).
4. Let not your heart be troubled: God really is like what you've seen in (14:7-11).
5. Let not your heart be troubled: Your best days with are still ahead (14:12-14).
Conclusion: Jesus troubles Himself for our comfort.
