CONFESSION OF SIN

LEADER: What is required in the first commandment?

PEOPLE: The first commandment requires us to know and acknowledge God as the only true God, and our God, and to worship and glorify him accordingly.

LEADER: What is forbidden in the first commandment?

PEOPLE: The first commandment forbids denying or not worshiping and glorifying the true God as God, and our God; it also forbids giving of that worship and glory, which is due to him alone, to anyone or anything else.
