Sermon Notes

Grace Group Questions (for fuller discussion guide, visit southwood.org) 1. In what ways do Christians in our Huntsville culture face persecution? Is it different from the rest of the world? In what ways do other parts of the world face persecution?

2. Knowing that Jesus warns us that persecution is not an if but a when, how do the teachings of the Scriptures call us to respond to our enemies and persecutors? (James 1:2-18, Matthew 5:38-48, etc.)

3. How does the presence of the Holy Spirit encourage and help us when we face conflict over faith in Christ? What does John 15:26-27 tell us we will be empowered to do through the Holy Spirit?

4. Persecution, struggle, conflict and pain can be reasons that many people wrestle with their faith in Christ. Jesus says this whole section is to assure them of this certainty in the life we have in Christ. What things can we fix our eyes on that remind us of the great security we have in Christ?
